## **Presbytery Consultation**

Spirited Consulting has been invited by the Synod of Queensland to undertake a review of the Qld Presbyteries.

The Review will specifically look at each Presbytery's role of "responsibility for such pastoral and administrative oversight as is necessary to the life and mission of the Church within the bounds and to stimulate and encourage congregations within the bounds, in their strengthening and assistance of one another and in their participation in the wider aspects of the work of the Church" (regulation 3.4.4). The purpose of our review will be to create an overview of our current practices, establish key priorities and actions for the next 3-5 years and to possibly look at recommendations to go to Presbytery, Synod (it's boards and agencies) and Assembly.

As part of the review process, Carolyn Kitto, will be meeting with ministers and church councils of congregations within our presbytery at various locations between Saturday 15th and Monday 24th October and your prayers for these conversations would be appreciated. Conversations will revolve around key aspects of our Presbytery: Inner City Congregations, our Northern Congregations, our larger congregations, our Youth and our suburban congregations. The meetings will be specifically looking at how the Presbytery is supporting, overseeing, stimulating and encouraging it's congregations, how they are overseeing the life and mission of the church within its bounds, how they are best utilising, deploying and developing the people who lead the life and mission of the Church within the bounds and how effective are they in the processes required of them by congregations, Synod and Assembly.
