### Supporting young people with a disability with training and employment

UCQ will soon launch a new initiative that supports young people with a disability to secure an internship, providing on-the-job training. Trainees will learn a number of skills required in large service-based organisations such as hospitals, aged care environments, councils and hotels.

UCQ will launch Project Search over the next 12 months, a partnership between the Disability Leadership Unit and UnitingCare Health, initially involving The Wesley Hospital and St Andrew's War Memorial Hospital. Once it's established there is a plan to expand its reach across the organisation.

Large, service-based organisations have a number of low-skill but important roles that need to be fulfilled in areas such as laundry, kitchen and housekeeping. The participants will be trained in up to three roles during a ten week rotation across a twelve month period. They will also learn other skills, such as working with others, punctuality and completing tasks. They will be supported with a work buddy and a mentor/job coach. At the end of the program they are welcome to apply for roles where they complete their internship or with other organisations. Project Search is a licensed and tested approach to employing young people with a disability in hospital settings. It is currently operating at 440 sites internationally. In the United States, Project Search has 268 program sites. Between 2013-2014 over 2000 young people with intellectual and developmental disabilities took part in the program.
