

Open House – Albert Street Uniting Church Saturday 13th October 2018 9am - 4pm

One of the most picturesque settings of the inner City is at the corner of Albert and Ann Streets, where two giant buildings dominate the skyline. Down at their feet, nestled in a garden setting on a slight rise is an architectural gem built in the Victorian Gothic Revival style. Viewed from King George Square the Albert Street Uniting Church makes as pretty a picture as you would find on any postcard.

Come and visit our 129 year old Heritage listed church this Open Day and take in the beautiful wood interior and stunning pipe organ. Built in 1888-89 and designed by George Addison of Messrs. Oakden, Addison and Kemp, Albert Street features a number of design modifications to Gothic revival in response to Brisbane's sub-tropical climate. A number of stained glass windows commemorate past events including a set of nine displaying knights to honour the memory of those lost in World War 2. Volunteers will be on hand to answer any questions during your self-quided tour.

Minimising your Risk of Dementia – FREE Information Morning Tuesday 23 October 2018, 10.00 am – 12 noon Merthyr Road Uniting Church, 52 Merthyr Rd, New Farm



If you ask most people what they most fear about growing old they will probably list things such as having to go into a nursing home, getting dementia, and having ill health - all things which are many of us associate with aging. However growing old isn't necessarily just about those things, and there is much we can do to minimise our risk of most of them.

As there is no known cure for any of the dementias, it's incidence is increasing and it is the second leading cause of death in Australia much research is currently being focussed on prevention. While there are some risks that can't be modified, e.g. age and genetics, there are many that can.

Researchers estimate that if people modified their lifestyle in certain ways then it would be possible to eliminate approximately one third of all dementia and, while it is highly desirable to have done this by midlife, it is actually never too early and never too late to start. And in minimising our risk of dementia we are also minimising our risk of needing to go into a nursing home or becoming ill. The benefits of a few simple modifications are, in fact, enormous.

Sandgate Church celebrates 40 years with Bramble Bay Family Day Care

Last week Bramble Bay Family Day Care celebrated 40 years of supporting the care and education needs of the community with a birthday party held at the Sandgate Uniting Church. The morning of festivities brought together over 90 children along with educators and families. The fun activities included a multicultural musical show providing the children with a hands on opportunity to dance and make music with a range of traditional African instruments, as well as a sausage sizzle and birthday cake. The birthday cake was cut by Cathy Castelli who has been a coordinator with the Scheme for the past 27 years.

Reverend Anne Hulbert said that the Sandgate Uniting Church began the Family Day Care Scheme at its original site in 1978, and since 1994 the Church and Family Day Care Scheme team have enjoyed sharing the Church complex in Board Street Deagon. The Scheme supports between 65 and 85 registered educators who offer quality care and education for children in their own home.

Sandgate Uniting Raised \$8,500 for Drought Relief

Reverend Anne Hulbert challenged the Sandgate Uniting Church to raise funds for drought relief, with a goal of \$5,000. The congregation was inspired and, besides retiring offerings, organised various fundraising activities including a High Tea raising over \$2000. Sandgate Uniting's close connection with Sandgate Blue Care and Bramble Bay Family Day Care also inspired these groups to fundraise and contributed another \$2000. BUT the church received such an awesome response that \$8,500 was raised, more than twice their target!
