Choose one person to be the leader. The leader says a combination of words (Happy/Sad, Stop/Go, Up/Down) and everyone else has to repeat the combination using opposite words. Start with simple combinations – Happy, Sad, Happy, Sad – and progress to more challenging combinations – Happy, Stop, Go, Sad OR Up, down, down, Sad, Stop. See if you can go faster and make the combinations longer. Have fun!!!


Prayer: Say a prayer using water.









Response: What is God saying to you today? You might like to draw a picture, write a letter to God, make something crafty, or act the story out with your toys or with the stick puppets below.









John 11: 1-45
