Day Camp @ Home Information Tuesday, 30 June – Friday, 3 July 2020

Day Camp is for children in Grades 1 to 6.

Day Camp is an activity of the Uniting Church in Australia, run by volunteers in local congregations to provide fun and excitement within a Christian environment for children in grades 1 to 6. Day Camp will be run a little differently this year but still in the June/July school holidays. Prep children may participate at the discretion of parents.

What is this Fusion Team?

FUSION TEAM is a leadership training program for young people in **grades 7 & 8**. It is a transition program designed to intentionally train and build up this group as they develop into fantastic leaders.

How does Day Camp @ Home work?

Due to the impact of Coronavirus (Covid-19) and our inability to meet safely face to face at the moment, Day Camp will be running in a combined at Home and Online format this year.

Each participating family will be provided with a Day Camp at Home pack that will contain materials and instructions for activities to complete at home.

Fusion Team will have 4x20min videos that can be viewed anytime during 30 June - 1 July. These videos will be recorded from the Fusion Directors about the leadership development areas that Day Camp looks at. Our recommendation would be to watch 2 videos per day.

Each afternoon there will also be an online catch-up session using the Zoom platform, facilitated by the Fusion Directors, for Fusion leaders to connect and chat with directors and each other about their day.

The online platforms (Church Online and Zoom) will only be accessible to Day Camp directors and Fusion participants via secure links sent directly to them. For all online sessions, at least 2 adult leaders will be present, and Day Camp Directors will monitor and screen video and chat functions as appropriate. Video recording of children will not happen through these platforms, and Parents/Guardians at home will be responsible for monitoring their own children's participation and behaviour at these times.

Participation in these live-online platforms is not a required part of Day Camp – but is something that we are offering to provide participants with the opportunity to connect and

share with Fusion directors and other Fusion participants during this time. If you do not give permission for your children to participate in these functions, please identify this at registration.

We have included here some guidelines for using online video platforms that we would like you to follow, to keep everyone safe and secure in this new way of meeting together.

Clothing:

Please wear suitable casual clothing that would usually be worn for face-to-face activities. Please do not wear pyjamas.

Background:

Please use a public space in the family home (not a bedroom).

You might want to use a virtual background or blur your background for extra privacy. You can do this in Zoom, and we can show you how in the first meeting.

Behaviour:

Please treat everyone with respect and kindness, as you would in a normal group setting.

Please set a positive example with your behaviour – keep in mind that other people (including your own and other families) will be able to see what you are doing when using the video setting in zoom.

Safety measures

All sessions will occur via secure links to Church Online and Zoom, with at least two adult leaders present. Parent permission is required to use these platforms and must be given at registration. A parent/guardian should also be nearby for online sessions to be able to monitor participation, behaviour and to assist with technology as required.
